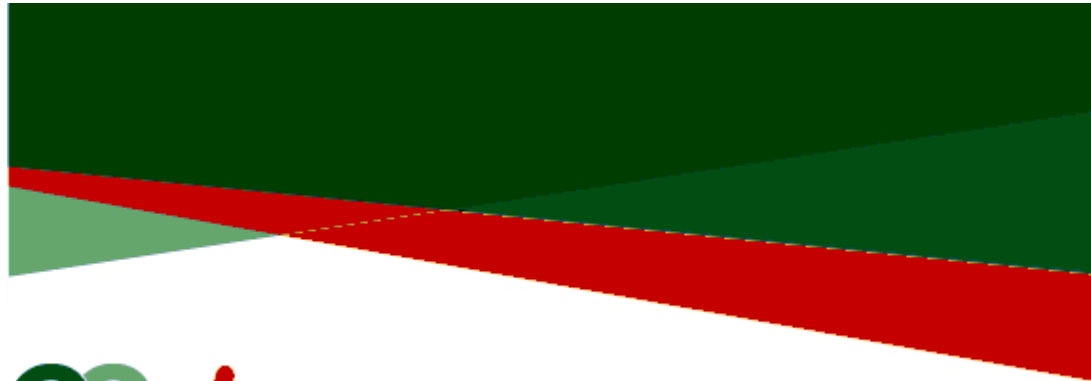

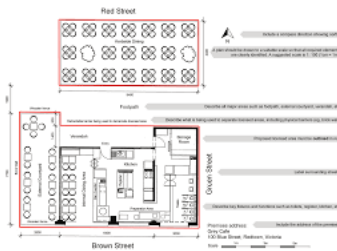

Red Line Plan - Liquor Licensing

No matter the size or type of your club - yes, **even tennis clubs** - it is your club's obligation under the Liquor Control Reform Act 1998 to:

- always have a copy of the red-line plan at your premises
- produce it if requested by Victoria Police or a VCGLR inspector

If you get a visit from Victoria Police or a VCGLR inspector, it is likely that they will ask for a copy of your plan and will check that you are operating within the red line. It is therefore important that if your club has a liquor licence, all staff and committee members know at all times where the red-line plan is kept.

Pay Attention When Checking IDs this Summer

You and your staff need to be particularly vigilant when checking identification (ID) in the lead up to summer and school leavers season. Licensees are reminded to:

- ask for ID if a customer looks under 25 as best practice
- not only check IDs but make sure they are an [acceptable form of ID](#)
- be familiar with the [keypass design](#) and its [digital format](#)
- refresh your knowledge on minors by doing the [minors quiz](#) or [listening to the minors audio](#)
- display your 2018 licence and [required signage](#)
- [provide free drinking water](#)

The VCGLR has a range of resources available on our website, including [fact sheets](#), a [licensees' action plan](#) and [intoxication guidelines](#) to assist licensees in understanding their obligations before the school leavers season kicks off.

A reminder that [in many instances](#), it's an offence for a minor to serve, purchase, receive or consume alcohol. If a customer is found to have a fake ID, this should be seized immediately, unless it is a drivers licence, and handed to Victoria Police.
